A SPECIAL SESSION FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS AT BACCH

Another day for medical students at BACCH on February 11 will focus on introducing them to the field of pediatric palliative care. This special session aims to equip future healthcare professionals with the knowledge and compassion needed to support children and their families through challenging times. Doctors and specialists from KACCH & BACCH shared their insights and experiences, emphasizing the importance of empathetic communication and holistic care.





Multidisciplinary Day Update

Continuing our ongoing efforts to host multidisciplinary days aimed at supporting various specialties for our patient groups. in April, we organized a session on neuromuscular dystrophy in collaboration with different doctors to better assist our patients. This initiative addresses their medical needs promptly, especially considering that certain appointments at government hospitals can take up to six months to secure.

In October 2024, the Global Treehouse Foundation launched the Magnify Tool, a customizable resource for children's palliative care providers, featuring 10 focus areas and over 100 metrics to assess service data. KACCH & BACCH participated in a 6-month Magnify Tool Cohort to explore its usability, focusing on service utilization and operational efficiency. Noor Safar and Dr. Spandana Rayala, with support from the cohort team, worked on a change management project, learning valuable lessons. They are set to present their final project on May 30th.

A special thanks to our colleagues who contributed to this effort: Maram Saleh, Lina Diab, Laila Sobuh, and Dr. Reham Jalal for their contributions and advice.
